TAKE THE FOLLOWING COURSES:

MINIMUM GRADE OF "C" REQUIRED

AREA II

TAKE ANY 1000-2000 LEVEL COURSE IN LITERATURE. 3 HOURS

TAKE ANY 1000-2000 LEVEL COURSE WITH AN EXPANDED HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL SCOPE IN THE FINE ARTS INCLUDING THE DISCIPLINES OF ART, MUSIC, THEATRE, FILM, OR OTHER FINE ARTS AREAS. 3 HOURS
