Director's Notes

We're stitched together ourselves, then we're all stitched together to form communities, tribes, families that are richly diverse and complex. That is to be appreciated, and it reminds us that nothing is truly singular, that change is part of the journey, and that no one is alone. Truly.

So, too, is Into the Woods an amalgamation of many stories, many characters, many circumstances, all the pieces and parts fastened together to create something whole, richly diverse and complex. I've enjoyed watching this company of performers, designers, technicians, and managers find ways to fit together, to stitch our patches to one another, to overlap our colors and shapes and textures, to bring our individual, beautiful messes and perfections into one central, combined effort. It has been a delight and an honor to work with these incredibly creative, generous, hardworking people.

Our take on this story is a game of patchwork pretend, of imagination and make believe. We offer the audience only the essentials and ask them to join in and play along in the storytelling, to extend their imaginations to fill in the blanks to make meaning of their own, and to use their senses to create a full picture.

Finally, we are reminded that "wishes are children." There is so much to be protected in us and in the world. We look toward the childishness of these tales and their characters, the world of this play, and the hearts and minds of everyone gathered around the telling of these stories to remember...everyone was once a child.

We hope you enjoy the journey, that you leave here humming the songs, and that you carry forward the light of your hopes and wishes to share with others.

To this end, each production entered is eligible for a response by a regional KCACTF representative, and selected students and faculty are invited to participate in KCACTF programs involving scholarships, internships, grants and awards for actors, directors, dramaturgs, playwrights, designers, stage managers and critics at both the regional and national levels. Productions entered on the Participating level are eligible for invitation to the KCACTF regional festival and may also be considered for national awards recognizing outstanding achievement in production, design, direction and performance. Last year more than 1,500 productions were entered in the KCACTF involving more than 200,000 students nationwide. By entering this production, our theater department is sharing in the KCACTF goals to recognize, reward, and celebrate the exemplary work produced in college and university theaters across the nation.
